Dorm Day Supervision

Educational Requirements

1. Must have a high school diploma or equivalency.

Age and Experience Requirements

- 1. Day supervision staff's age is preferred to be 25 years old, but must be at least 21 years of age at the time of appointment.
- 2. Some experience in working with youth is preferred.

Duties

- 1. Encourage spiritual growth in clients by:
 - Providing an example through living a life consistent with Christian principles.
 - Assisting and/or conducting worships for clients as needed.
 - Mentoring clients on spiritual issues through prayer, bible study, and one on one discussion.
- 2. Supervise youth in care during scheduled shift.
- 3. Plan with others on shift to organize work, recreation, educational, and worship activities during scheduled shift.
- 4. Facilitate, or assist in facilitating level groups as requested.
- 5. Coordinate all activities with shift leader.
- 6. Complete all paperwork and reports as required or requested.
- 7. Distribute medications per policy.
- 8. Conduct Wilderness programs as needed.
- 9. Conduct Work Crew as needed.
- 10. Attend all staff meetings and training as required.
- 11. Complete twenty (20) hours of ongoing training/continuing education annually.
- 12. Communicate dorm concerns to shift leader.
- 13. Supervise KP, and assure that the kitchen meets appropriate cleanliness standards.
- 14. Ensures completion of all client responsibilities and chores to acceptable standards. I.e.-maintains mowers, puts tools away, checks chores and tasks, makes sure school is cleaned appropriately, etc.
- 15. Actively participate in work, recreation, and educational activities with the clients. Many of these may be strenuous or arduous in nature.
- 16. Ensure adherence to the Level Program.
- 17. Maintain open and appropriate lines of communication with other departments and co-workers.
- 18. Promote and abide by PATCH policies, procedures, and standards.
- 19. Provide for the care, welfare, safety, and security of the clients in our care.
